Remember this parade is at dusk so it will be dark.

Safety Guidelines
 Drivers of floats must be at least 21 years of age, have a license for the vehicle being operated, and must have liability insurance.

NO CANDY or other items are allowed to be thrown from floats or vehicles!!! This causes children along the route to run into the street and into the path of the parade vehicles. If you want to give candy, please have walkers along the sides to pass it out!! Anyone throwing anything from a parade entry will be disqualified as a future parade participant.

Small Children will not be allowed to ride on top of cars.

It is strongly recommended that you wear proper safety equipment (helmet, pads, etc.) if you are riding a motorcycle, 4-wheeler, tractor, go-kart or bicycle. If you choose not to wear safety equipment you do so at your own risk.

 The parade will begin at the intersection of Railroad Street and W Main Street heading downtown and coming to an end at Tooley Street.
